## **Accommodation** On-campus housing is available to the accepted international students.

- All the exchange students get priority when applying for on-campus housing. However the dormitory is triple room type only and students need to meet the application deadline to get a space.
- Housing Application Deadline : July 20th for Fall Sem. / Jan. 20th for Spring Sem.
- Housing Application Form : will be offered after the application review
- Housing Fee: 480,000KRW per semester(15 class weeks, appx. \$450)
- Extra stay will be charged by day and students need to specify the exact period when applying.
